

Pullman City Council meeting: December 4, 2018

Present: Brandon Chapman, Pat Wright, Dan Records, Glenn Johnson, Ann Parks, Al Sorensen, and Nathan Weller

Absent: Eileen Macoll: excused

Update on warming shelter: Family Promise of the Palouse has offered to take on the responsibility of the warming shelter at Encounter Ministries for this winter season only. Adam Lincoln said it would take \$5,000 to update the building (door locks, smoke detectors, exit signs) which would take 2-3 weeks. The basement of the church building would be the location. Nathan Weller would be the volunteer coordinator. At least two volunteers will be on duty at all time. Operational hours: 8 pm to 6 am. Adam Lincoln asked if there would be a fee for using the building. Dan Records made a motion to move forward; Nathan seconded. Passed unanimously.

Confirmation of Reappointments: all approved.

Consent agenda: two items pulled because protected classes language was not complete. Dan Records brought this up. Approved with this change. Al Sorensen asked about **internet and phone service at the airport**. He has received numerous complaints about these two items.

Ordinance: **Changing the term “city supervisor”** to “city administrator” in the City Code. Approved.

Zoning change in comprehensive plan for the **5.8 acres at 190 SE Crestview St. from R1 to C3-L** with stipulation that the land can only be used for governmental purposes. Moved by Pat Wright; seconded by Nathan Weller. Passed with one nay from Al Sorensen.

Proposed **annexation of 160 acres to the city owned by Donald and Shirley Quist**. Location: west end of SW Crestview on Sunnyside Hill. Moved by Al Sorensen; seconded by Brandon. Passed unanimously. (R1 zoning stipulated.)

Legislative priorities: support of the central business district was added. The items listed will all have funding requests submitted to the state legislature. Adopted unanimously.

Spring Street Parking lot time limits: The 12 hour stalls are primarily used by students. A proposal to revamp the time limits will be developed and brought back to the Council.
