## Overall:

<u>Top Priority</u>: Support for **downtown Revitalization** Project

Goals relate to economic development, transportation, safety (often combinations of).

Multiple councilors say the goals should include an "Ask" (ie. specific goals, \$, etc.)

## Topics of discussion/consideration:

<u>Bypass</u>- Wright mentions **South Bypass**. Sorenson not ready to commit to South. Sorenson wants Bypass discussion (*observer opinion: he seems to favor North*). Parks wants to direct \$ be given to design plan. (I.e. A specific "ask").

#### **Pullman Regional Airport**

<u>Housing Affordability</u>. Brought up by Records. Ties with employers' (ie. SEL) needs. Ask might be: Ways to entice developers to build affordable housing.

<u>Passing Lanes on Hwy 26</u>- Safely to and from WSU-Westside Non-motorized transport

Safe paths to schools

<u>Mental Health</u>. Goal: Increase access. Question- Should WA accept certification from other states? Does Zoom increase availability?

Outdoor recreation- i.e. redevelopment of playfields.

Council supports abandonment (v. banking) of railway lines.

City Supervisor notes that WSU presenting 'Gateway' Project at next City Council meeting.
