Quality of Instruction:

- Because of Covid level at moderate level now, district is **moving on to stage four**
- **PHS**—relationships matter (March 1st)
 - Keep students with their current teachers in their current classes
 - Schedule avoids having zoom in for six hours/day on their off day
 - Hybrid schedule in combination with distance learning
- **LMS**—same as high school (February 22nd)
 - Except that distance learners will have time with their teachers without being blended in with in-person students
- **Survey going out to parents** so students select in person or hybrid
- **Elementary** five days in person February 22nd
- 34% of staff have received first shot, **13% declined vaccine**
- **Ensuring compliance**
 - Remind, practice
 - Child-sized face masks
 - Where to report incidents and violations
 - Reach out to building administrator and Nurse Michelle Hyatt
- Update on **transportation issues**
 - Meeting with Pullman Transit
 - Worked up some preliminary ideas
 - In order to not change bell schedule
 - So, will need to run multiple routes
 - Early drop off with supervision at school
- **FAQ** will be developed to go out to parents/community to ensure good communication
