Business pertaining to League Positions or topics of interest:

Quality of Instruction:

- **State progress testing is postponed** from spring to fall 2021 (required permission from the federal department of education through an application for a waiver or postponement made by the state office of the superintendent of public instructions)
- **Jefferson has 2 in-person and 1 distance learning classroom on average per grade level** to give an idea of the proportion of students who are continuing in distance learning and those who are back to school full time in person
- Three different **options for graduation** depending on where we are at as a community vis a vis Covid reopening phase
- **Equity panel** with students in development, student facilitator identified

Responsible Use of Public Funds:

- **LMS extension and remodel** and three older elementary schools HVAC improvements are all on schedule
- Presentation of from-scratch and five-day **meal kits** for over holidays (five breakfasts and five lunches per child 1 year to 18 years based upon waivers with the federal government department of agriculture)
 - Can divert money to local growers
- **Summer program** may be daily or five-day
