Quality of Instruction:

- Change from Community Truancy Board to Community Engagement Board
- Zero in-school transmission of Covid-19 during the 2020/21 school year.

Responsible Use of Public Funds:

- Security Entrance at Lincoln Middle School was built into the remodel project
- Now <u>all schools</u> will have that level of security by the beginning of 2021-2022 school year
- Reconfigured bus routes, hope was that buses would not need to travel so much, has anyone compared savings afterward or was that interrupted by Covid?
 - o <u>Interrupted by Covid, but more important to gas savings</u> (which was anticipated with the change of routes) is the fact that the kids are not on the buses so long
- Purchasing power increased by joining the Spokane School District with school lunch expenses
- 1.2 million spent from rainy day fund b/c expenditures exceeded revenue
 - o 192 FTE down from previous year, all Covid-related, expect about half back
 - Federal monies from Covid relief are being spent on teachers at each school for learning recovery and para-pros to support that instruction

Public Comments:

- <u>James Clark-</u> re: SB 5044. "Institutional Racism is an established fact; I don't see that there is any
 institutional racism in the Pullman School District." Wants the school board to publicly reject Critical
 Race Theory.
- <u>Josie Clark-</u> School District Equity Statement (read from that), agrees with statement, will the new equity training be in-line with the district's statement?
- Sandi Brabb- District should create a committee about how to implement
- <u>Rick Grunewald-</u> I do believe in equal justice for all but CRT is harmful b/c it emphasizes racism, MLK Jr. focused on equality, CRT "promotes racism", "CRT is dangerous".

Your additional comments/opinions:

- Clarification—Dr. Maxwell: THERE ARE NO CHANGES TO STAFF TRAINING OR CURRICULUM (the WSSDA training is for School Boards ONLY)
- No one explained how the four speakers knew each other. Only the Clarks have children in the PSD currently.
- The Clarks did not mention any specifics about how this would affect their children.
