Business pertaining to League Positions or topics of interest:

The meeting was mostly a workshop where nothing was decided or voted on. The only formal, meeting decision, was **approval of \$400,000 toward the construction of the airport terminal**. <u>This was the full amount</u> <u>requested of the County</u>.

The Board was informed by the head of Public Works that a **new plan for a south by-pass for Pullman** is being considered. The route would start on Hwy 195 (Pullman to Lewiston) at Kirkindal Road then connect with Sand Road and go all the way to Moscow, *or join the current Pullman/Moscow Highway I wasn't clear*. This would make it possible for most truck traffic to not go through Pullman's downtown but would entail significant road construction paralleling the Pullman-Moscow highway. The cost is estimated to be in the area of \$10 million rather than closer to \$100 million for the currently visioned south by pass.

The Health Department reported that they expect **Covid numbers** to rise quickly for the next 4-5 weeks and then a sharp drop off is expected.

During the workshop there was mostly discussion related to the **IT system and upgrades**. Interestingly the IT Director said that Covid (and the special funds associated with it) has led to people having and now expecting to use greater on-line activity. Therefore, where he had hoped to upgrade a system that in 2019 was 10 years out of date over a few years the need for improvements is now immediate. The main expense would be in subscribing to computer systems that do all kinds of things (sorry this is the best I can do with my limited interest in anything computer).

Process & Protocol:

The meeting was on Zoom and live but most people participated by Zoom. Everyone was very cordial.
