## **Workshop**

Discussion of use of **Historic Preservation funds** that accrue from fees. Current balance is about \$73,000 Funds have not been used for a while as balance had gotten very low. Will explore opening grant opportunities for towns, cities, and historic preservation groups.

## **BOCC Meeting**

A lobbyist for a statewide organization of town and county governments gave a legislative update. At this point not much chatter about local needs, some concern about solvency of family leave funds.

Various project funds were approved for road and bridge work.

Sale of surplus vehicles was approved.

A letter of support for a **Community Action Center Grant** application to the department of Commerce to sponsor up to five Ukrainian refugee families was unanimously approved.
